

# 2012 UNIMUTUAL STUDENT FILM FESTIVAL

## ENTRY GUIDELINES

Welcome to the inaugural 2012 Unimutual Student Film Festival.

Unimutual is a not-for-profit discretionary mutual that was formed to offer higher education and research institutions a commercially feasible alternative to insurance. Members include universities and other higher education institutions that have joined together for the protection of their assets and liabilities, and to “Protect Wisdom”.

Unimutual is interested in promoting teaching and learning and is organising the inaugural Unimutual Student Film Festival at its 2012 conference in Sydney on 6 September 2012. We are seeking student-made, short films to feature at the conference and to qualify for prizes. The following are submission guidelines.

### ALL FILMMAKERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

- The contest is open to all **currently registered** students of Unimutual Member institutions. See the Member Rep Chart for list of Unimutual Members.
- There is no set theme for the 2012 Unimutual Student Film Festival, all subjects are welcome. Submit your best!
- All submissions should be made through the Unimutual Member Representative at your institution. See the Member Rep Chart for a list of representatives.
- All films must be submitted in a DVD format, and be compatible for playing by Windows Media Player or similar standard PAL video format.
- All DVDs are to be delivered to or sent via internal mail to your Unimutual Representative. Only one film per student will be accepted.
- Short Films are to be a maximum of seven minutes in length (including title and credits)
- Short Films must meet the Australian government classification of: M (Mature)
- Short Films must contain only original content; any copied sources (ie music) must be acknowledged. Students must have appropriate release forms from actors.
- Films can be either animated or live action.

SIMPLY SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY DIRECTLY TO THE UNIMUTUAL REPRESENTATIVE OF YOUR UNIVERSITY INSURANCE OFFICE. Please include the following information with each submission:

- Student name
- University/institution
- Film title
- Contact details: email/mobile phone.

Once you have completed your submission, you will receive a confirmation email from Unimutual.
